a. James Maddox Gloria Drive Garbage Pickup and the water waste all over the road. Send a letter to the county commissioner from the town and residence addressing the garbage truck leaking yuck on the roads. Mayor told everyone there are many waste disposal companies all over the state of Alabama. That would love to pick up our garbage.

b. Daniel Griffin Eddie Dr. April 15, 2017 Hometown Lenders holding a 5 k run at Oak Mountain State park. Hometown Heroes Run. This is a scholarship fund for police officers children. Family Fun Day. Hope to raise 18,000.00.

Daniel Griffin stated that he don't believe in ambushing folks and sneak up on things. I am bring this formula to the council. About the septic and sewer system at Municipal building. About two weeks ago I met with a group of other citizens we have started circulating a petition. We have gathered about 200 signatures. We will continue till the next month. I have gathers a large portion of the citizens that don't want our public building and public monies to go to any kind of sewer system. As long as the town can remain septic we want the town to be septic. He will have the list ready to give to the Town Clerk and verified by the registers voters list before the next council meeting.

Paul Calhoun stated that he has got 3 phone call asking him why am I supporting of this petition. Someone it was a female that is working on this petition group has been telling people that the Mayor is in full support of this. Mayor Paul told everyone he is NOT in support of this. Mayor is support of liberty and let people do what they want to do with their property. Not strong arming people. Mayor Paul was here when the town was formed. Mayor Paul don't like his name being used as a card try to dupe people in deciding something he does not support.

Terry explained that this issue is not a Municipal issue this is the Fire Department issue. The Fire Department is a separate entity. The City is concerned about the Fire Department. The building can't be staffed because of the septic problem. The City is looking for all other means to try and get the Fire Department staffed. Buying additional land, paying for surveys, soil samples we are stuck by Alabama Law on what they will approve. No way to buy land. We are waiting for all the facts to come in before we make a discussion. Daniel Griffin stated that the survey stated that the town's property has enough space for a septic tank for the town and fire department together to be connected.

Paul explained that if you look at the survey it shows that there is enough room for the filed lines. We took the application and the survey with the survey from Mr. Thornton to the Health Department.

Don't look at what you see now. Within 5 to 15 years no room for field lines for the Fire Department and field line for the town. Because of the new construction. Our field lines will be under pavement.

Paul stated the use of his name I have not heard of any gentleman using my name with that I am assuming that it's just females. I have written statements for the females that was told that Paul was in support of the petition. If I get another call in support of this petition. I will get written letters from that individual I will be in pursuit of those that are in charge of this petition.
